- Plan, conduct, monitor and adjust individualised long term, high performance training programs
- Develop and implement a comprehensive pre-season and in-season training program
- Undertake related administrative tasks such as booking venues etc.
- Take of the role of Chair of Selectors for the premier cricket teams
- Teaching techniques for players to acquire additional skills or improve existing skills
- Actively support Cricket Victoria's Junior Development Program within the region
- Attend scheduled training sessions and club matches across all grades
- Attend and assist with the running of training sessions at local community women's clubs
- Liaise with the assistant coach/es, selection panel, community grade Team Manager and committee where required
- Manage player queries and respond as necessary
